Secretary’s Report

Director’s Report

1. Renee Waldron reviewed her report and answered questions.
 - a. The details for summer programming are being worked on. Candidates for summer camp staff are being interviewed.
 - b. The Easter Egg Hunt scheduled for March 28th is being rescheduled to a later date in April or early May.
 - c. Most of the surveys distributed to school children have been returned and the data is being compiled.
 - d. The After School Program is having staffing issues due to an increase in half days. The Commission discussed possibly increasing fees or updating the payment plan to cover the costs.

Old Business

1. Park Committee Report
 - a. Once the snow has melted, a list of damages in the parks will be compiled and presented to the Board of Finance.
 - b. Purely Recreation after school program—No update.

New Business

1. The Blain Road Footbridge on West Thompson Lake needs to be replaced. UCONN’s Civil Engineering department has agreed to take on the project and is looking for the town to contribute towards the cost of \$7,000.

- a. **Cathy Thomas moved and Cynthia Antos seconded the motion to expend \$1,000 from the proceeds from the Turkey Trot to go towards the engineering fee for the Blain Road Footbridge. The motion carried unanimously.**


